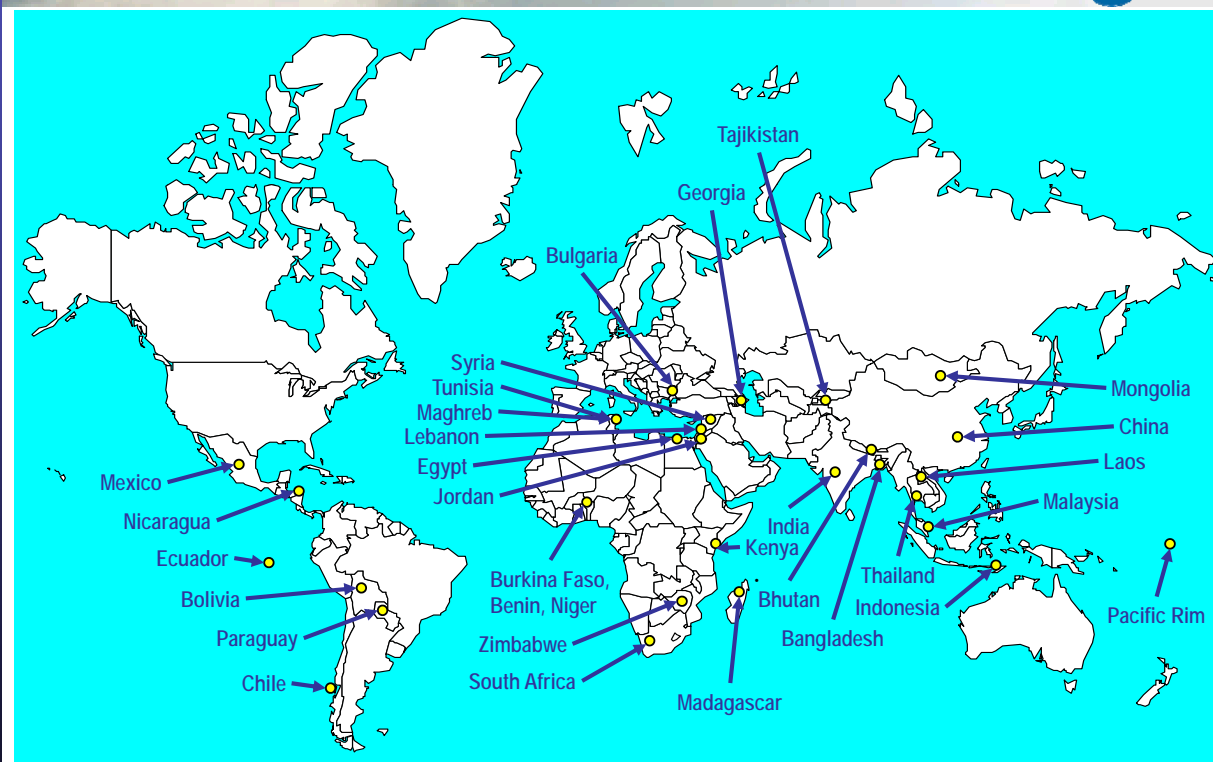
e8 Strategic Objectives

Education for Sustainable Energy Development- ESED



- Scholarships to support outstanding students in pursuing advanced studies in sustainable energy development and to encourage meaningful contributions to the collective body of knowledge about the subject.
- Eligibility: students from developing countries and economies in transition who plan to undertake studies at the Masters or Post-Doctoral level in areas directly related to sustainable energy development.
- Six Post-doctoral scholarships and 32 Masters scholarships awarded since 2001.
